1. If I believe in God, I will go to Heaven.	False	It is not enough to believe in God. The devils believe in God and won't go to Heaven. James 2:19 Those believest that there is one God; thou doest well: the devils also believe, and tremble.
2. To go to Heaven, I must do good works.	False	We are not saved by our works. Titus 3:5 Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy he saved us, by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Ghost; Romans 3:10 As it is written, There is none righteous, no, not one: Romans 3:12 They are all gone out of the way, they are together become unprofitable; there is none that doeth good, no, not one.
3. To go to Heaven, I must keep the Ten Commandments.	False	No one can be saved by keeping the law. Romans 3:20 Therefore by the deeds of the law there shall no flesh be justified in his sight: for by the law [is] the knowledge of sin. James 2:10 For whosoever shall keep the whole law, and yet offend in one [point], he is guilty of all.
4. To go to Heaven, I have to quit sinning.	False	We are not saved by stopping sinning but by believing on the Lord Jesus Christ. Romans 4:5 But to him that worketh not, but believeth on him that justifieth the ungodly, his faith is counted for righteousness.
5. All that I must do to be saved is believe the gospel that Jesus Christ died for my sins, was buried, and rose again.	True	Acts 16:30 And brought them out, and said, Sirs, what must I do to be saved? Acts 16:31 And they said, Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou shalt be saved, and thy house. Ephesians 2:8 For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: [it is] the gift of God: Ephesians 2:9 Not of works, lest any man should boast.
6. It is not enough to simply have faith in Jesus Christ, I must also do good works to go to Heaven.	False	Romans 11:6 And if by grace, then [it is] no more of works: otherwise grace is no more grace. But if [it be] of works, then is it no more grace: otherwise work is no more work.
7. Believers who sin or quit believing after being saved lose their salvation.	False	Ephesians 1:13 In whom ye also [trusted], after that ye heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also after that ye believed, ye were sealed with that holy Spirit of promise, Ephesians 1:14 Which is the earnest of our inheritance until the redemption of the purchased possession, unto the praise of his glory. 2 Timothy 2:13 If we believe not, [yet] he abideth faithful: he cannot deny himself.
